

General Purpose Contact Cement



DESCRIPTION

POWERHOLD™ 500 is a solvent-based rubber-resin general-purpose contact adhesive used for a wide variety of bonding applications.

USE FOR

Typical applications include bonding veneers, paneling, ceramic tile, stair treads, risers, cove base, transition and tack strips to other substrates.

BONDS TO

Wood, vinyl, rubber, leather, drywall, concrete, glass, ceramics and metal.

Test areas must be installed to determine suitability for intended use.

PREPARATION

READ ALL WARNINGS, FULL INSTRUCTIONS AND MSDS BEFORE OPENING CONTAINER.

Stir thoroughly with a wooden or metal paint paddle or stirring stick. Pre-fit all parts before applying.

Bonding surfaces must be clean, dry and free of wax, oil or other release agents before applying.

INSTALLATION

Using a paintbrush, short nap roller or finishing trowel, apply an even coat of adhesive to both surfaces.

Allow adhesive to dry (approx. 5 to 10 min at 70°F/21°C).

Position pieces accurately as adhesive bonds instantly. Apply moderate pressure to ensure complete contact.

CLEANUP

Apply carefully as adhesive is difficult to remove when dry.

WARRANTY

- Freeze / Thaw: Not affected by freezing.
- Shelf life is 1 year, if unopened.
